2. **Probation/Social Services/HM Prisons** - for improved social awareness, extended choices of supervision and observation services and for addressing specific offending patterns/occurrences.
3. **YOS/Other-** for work with unemployment clients in need Personal & Social Development and in re-integration to EET
4. **Local Police** - for maximising chances of successful ASBOs & Cautions(+) orders and for citizenship involvement
5. **Local Magistrates-** for implementation of 'Requirements' under new CJA and for increased sentencing options.
6. **Careers Guidance/Youth Advisory Services** - all 16-25 YPs in need of additional support within safe environments
7. **Schools/Colleges (16-19)-** for additional support in Behaviour Management/ Sustained Career Development
8. **Employment Service** - for supporting staff from the New Deal/other ES provisions in dealing with difficult clients
9. **Other Client Referral Services** (e.g. NHS/Mental Health/Drug & Alcohol Awareness, etc.) under specified partnership agreements/support mechanisms
