**Programme Duration:** over 4 weeks, including one (or two) session per week, each lasting up to 1.5 hours.

**Programmes Frequency:** each programme will last up to 4 weeks and will commence in Immediately prior to each scheduled Behaviour Management or Occupational development Programme (see other programmes' start times throughout each year).
